

1. Help your waste disposal company to process plastics efficiently by rinsing containers and removing their lids (which are often a different type of plastic from the container) before placing them in your recycling bin.
2. Plastic bags can mess up the disposal company's sorting machines and should not be placed in your recycling bin. Most local grocery stores will accept them.
3. Please use the blue recycling bins in the kitchen and the PLC only for recyclable items like food-free plastics and clean cans or paper.
4. If you have electronics, medicines or unusual items to dispose of, check web sites like swancc.org or earth911.com for the best places to recycle them in our area.
