

## Easter Vigil Reception Internal Service Project Summary

This project always takes place on Holy Saturday, the night before Easter. After the Easter Vigil mass, the parish is invited to the Community Room to enjoy various appetizers. The purpose of this service project is to assist with the preparation, serving, and clean-up for this reception. Three groups are assigned to work and each group should provide eight volunteers. Volunteers will be given the option to work one of three shifts. Shelly Macina and Laura Wiertel are the coordinators of the Easter Vigil Reception. Shelly or Laura will get in touch with the group leader a few weeks prior to the event. They will give the leader the times of the shifts and request a list of volunteers from your group. It is not necessary for everyone in your group to work the same shift. The leader should give Shelly or Laura the names, phone numbers, and email addresses of the volunteers from your group. Once your group has signed up for your shifts, all you have to do is show up. There is no advance work required. The first shift is in the morning – usually from 8am to 11am. This team prepares the appetizers that will be served that night. Ingredients and recipes are provided. The second shift is around 8pm to 10pm. This group is responsible for heating up and setting up all the appetizers so they are ready to be served to the parish when mass is over. The third group arrives around 9 or 9:30 pm and stays until 11:30 pm. This group helps replenish and serve the appetizers and also stays for the clean-up once the reception is over.
