OUR PLAN FOR 2020-2021

This year, our RE program will look a bit different from past years. While we would love to have on-site instruction, our current public health situation and limited resources (time, money, space) makes it clear that in-person learning will not be feasible for RE.

The funny thing is, while we were forced to think "outside the box", we realized that putting everything into a box actually makes the most sense! Similar to a "monthly subscription box", each child/youth will receive the required curriculum, lessons, and activities (see below for more details and information).

The name of this program offering: BOXED-In (short for B.O.X.E.D. Instruction) +From the way we might look at our faith, from the feeling of quarantine, for the way we are keeping our materials organized for the year, BOXED-In will help us navigate through our Belief, cOvenant, eXamen, Eucharist, and Devotion as Catholic-Christians

Our goal with BOXED-In is to minimize computer use/screen time by learning offering all a meaningful, hands-on learning experience for children/youth.

The purpose of a box for the BOXED-In program is to create a "home base" for all of your supplies and assignments for the year.



Patients at Northwest Community Hospital

In late October we received word from the Spiritual Care Services Department at Northwest Community Hospital that they will no longer send the daily patient census to the Ministry of Care Coordinators at the parishes and other churches. Up to this time, Sr. Val received a confidential listing of St. Raymond parishioners at NCH, enabling us to offer the pastoral care that we want to provide for our parishioners experiencing illness requiring hospital care. Due to this change in policy, there is no way to know if any of our parishioners are at NCH. Therefore, if a loved one has been hospitalized at NCH, we would deeply appreciate a call or email with this information. This is also true for patients at Lutheran General, Alexian Brothers, and Resurrection Hospitals. St. Raymond Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

AWARENESS

Domestic violence is a pattern of behavior. It is used to exert power and control over another person. It is found in the context of a dating, family or household relationship.

Questions to ask:

- Does your partner isolate you from family and friends?
- Are you being physically, psychologically, economically or sexually abused?
- Is your partner attempting to destroy your self-esteem and self-confidence?

Domestic violence victims often report: "I didn't know it was abuse." "I thought I could fix it.", "I didn't tell anyone."

These are traps that keep people bound. Domestic violence. Dating Violence. No Excuse
