#### 4. The Presentation

When the day came to purify them according to the Law of Moses, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus up to Jerusalem so that He could be presented to the Lord.

### 5. Finding in the Temple

They came upon Him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions. All who heard Him were amazed.

# **The Luminous Mysteries**

### 1. The Baptism of Jesus

#### The Seven Sorrows of Mary

### 1. Mary hears the prophesy of Simeon

"Rise, take the child and his mother and flee to Egypt....

Herod is going to search for the child to destroy him."

Mary, so often I am overwhelmed with sorrow, especially over the illnesses of family and friends. Give me the joy of your presence in my life, and let me know the healing hand of your loving Son. (Hail Mary)

### 3. Mary and Joseph are separated from Jesus

"The boy Jesus remained behind in Jerusalem but his parents did not know it."

Mary, there are so many things I find difficult to understand or impossible to accept. Help me over these hurdles and bring me home to a believing and peaceful way of life. (Hail Mary)

### 4. Mary meets Jesus carrying the cross

"A large crowd of people followed Jesus, including many women who mourned and lamented him."

Mary, your Son asks me to take up my cross daily and follow Him. Please be with me, as you were with Him, that I may do so in a spirit of penance, for I know that he is merciful toward me. (Hail Mary)

#### 5. Mary stands beneath the cross of Jesus

"Standing by the cross of Jesus were His mother Mary. . ."
Mother Mary, as I contemplate Jesus on the cross for our salvation, may I be privileged to stand together with you, and with John and Mary Magdelene, to join there in your own sorrow and love for my Saviour. (Hail Mary)

#### 6. Mary receives the body of Her Son

"They took the body of Jesus and bound it with burial cloths along with spices"

Mary, may I be as tender and forgiving toward others, even those who have hurt me, as you and your Son were at that terrible moment on Calvary. (Hail Mary)

# 7. Mary grieves as Jesus is buried

"In the place where He had been crucified there was a garden, in the garden a new tomb. . . so they laid Jesus there."

Mary, Mother of mercy, be with me at all the most difficult moments of my life, especially when I have the most doubts or fears. May I one day come to know the joys of eternal life with you and your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen. (Hail Mary)
