

Did you know that the **Invest in Kids Act** helps children from low-income households in Illinois access scholarships that cover up to 100 percent of a Catholic school's tuition? Thousands of students are gaining knowledge and building on their faith in Archdiocese of Chicago Catholic Schools thanks to this program. Your support during these challenging times would help educate the next generation in Catholic students while building on a brighter future for all.

What is a tax credit scholarship?

Tax Credit Scholarships cover up to 100 percent of tuition and fees for the 2021/22 school year. Students from low-income households can qualify for tax credit scholarships if their family income is less than \$72,900. More than 9,000 students qualified for a scholarship last year and 6,300 were left waiting without one.

You will receive your Contribution Authorization Certificate (CAC) via email. Once you have your CAC, you are ready to donate.

3 DONATE

Once you receive confirmation of your tax credit and your CAC from IDOR, you have up to 60 days to donate to Empower Illinois. For more help, refer to page 7 of this **step-by-step guide**.



All about the Advert Wreath

Advent is a time of
LONGING AND WAITING for
the Lord to come. The
Advent Wreath is a symobol
used as a way to prayerfully
reflect, in anticipation of
what is to come.

The wreath is usually made from evergreen branches forming a circle and topped with 4 candles - 3 purple (Hope, Love, & Peace) and 1 pink (Joy).

ADVENT 2020

November 29 - December 24

The wreath of EVERGREENS,
which has no beginning or end,
reminds us of God's promise
of everlasting life through
the gift of Jesus Christ, sent
down and made flesh to save us.

The wreath is blessed and one candle is lit on the first Sunday of Advent; a candle is lit every Sunday until four are burning brightly.

During this time we recall the past, celebrate the present, and look to the future with hope.

The act of LIGHTING THE CANDLES each week symbolozes the hope and expecation of the Lord's first coming into the world and serves as a reminder that Jesus Christ, is the Light for the world that continues to shine brightly throughout his Church.

The PINK CANDLE for the third Sunday reminds us of the Joy brought to the world with the birth of Christ which is coming soon and we must continue to prepare.

The VIOLET CANDLES
symbolize our prayerful
preparation as we are
waiting and longing for the
arrival of Jesus Christ; the
color also signifies penance.

PRAYER

O God, as light comes from this candle, may the blessing of Jesus Christ come to us, warming our hearts and brightening our way. May Christ our Savior bring new life into the darkness of this world, and to us, as we wait for his coming. Amen
