# History of the Luminaria DECEMBER 2020



It all began when Renae McGovern befriended Dot Sheehan. Dot moved to the 400 block of South Pine Street from the State of Virginia. Dot had seen Luminaria there with milk jugs being used as the candle holders. Dot was organizing her block (400 & invited the 500 block) to join her with lighting Luminaria on Christmas Eve of 1981. Renae asked if she could join them in 1982 after witnessing the candle lit milk jugs down our street.

In 1982 Renae organized our block as well as St. Mark Lutheran Church along Evergreen Ave. She also asked Rev. Robert J. Loftus, pastor of St. Raymond Parish if she could outline that block with



the same Luminaria candle glowing affect. He said "yes" and often took it upon himself to light candles as he walked around the block after inclement weather snuffed the candles out. Renae continued to organize with Dot Sheehan for 12 years.

In about or around 1993 Renae asked me to take on the



### PADS UPDATE

Thank you to all who have supported St. Mark PADS Site! Since March when PADS guests started sheltering in the hotels we have provided them with 5,381 meals. The guests will be sheltering at the hotels through March 2021.

In addition to the donations of time and food that we receive each week for the meal boxes and dinners, we received any generous donations which allowed us to provide Christmas gifts to 54 people, including 12 children. The true spirit of Christmas is shown through the caring and sharing we do for others.




