Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



I pray that, accompanied by the Lord, we may learn to be sources of encouragement for each other on the journey.



ADVENT 2021

November 28 - December 19

The wreath of EVERGREENS, which has no beginning or end, reminds us of God's promise of everlasting life through the gift of Jesus Christ, sent down and made flesh to save us.

The wreath is blessed and one candle is lit on the first Sunday of Advent; a candle is lit every Sunday until four are burning brightly. During this time we recall the past, celebrate the present, and look to the future with hope.

All about the advert Wreath

Advent is a time of LONGING AND WAITING for the Lord to come. The Advent Wreath is a symobol used as a way to prayerfully reflect, in anticipation of what is to come.

The wreath is usually made from evergreen branches forming a circle and topped with 4 candles - 3 purple (Hope, Love, & Peace) and 1 pink (Joy).

The act of LIGHTING THE CANDLES each week symbolozes the hope and expecation of the Lord's first coming into the world and serves as a reminder that Jesus Christ, is the Light for the world that continues to shine brightly throughout his Church.

The PINK CANDLE for the third Sunday reminds us of the Joy brought to the world with the birth of Christ which is coming soon and we must continue to prepare.

The VIOLET CANDLES symbolize our prayerful preparation as we are waiting and longing for the arrival of Jesus Christ; the color also signifies penance.

PRAYER

O God, as light comes from this candle, may the blessing of Jesus Christ come to us, warming our hearts and brightening our way. May Christ our Savior bring new life into the darkness of this world, and to us, as we wait for his coming. Amen





6th Grade Lead Annual Toy Drive

Students from 6th grade have been very busy this Advent season coordinating our annual school toy drive for the children of our sharing parish, Holy Family in Chicago. The 6th graders spoke to the younger classes about this school-wide service project and led the charge in promoting the project through posters and school announcements. They also tracked how many gifts were donated and provided updates so the school would know how close we were to reaching our goal of 400 presents. We are thrilled to announce that we surpassed our goal with 622 donated toys! SRS also collected over \$1,068 in spare change at the Book Fair to purchase 197 books to donate! Parent volunteers filled their "sleighs" and drove the gifts to Holy Family. The parish was overwhelmed with the generosity of SRS, and Deacon Larry Sorce offered a special blessing over the toys and our parent volunteers. This was truly a school community outreach. We are proud of the 6th graders and all of our SRS students and families for starting Christmas by sharing with others!













Do You Know Someone Who Might Be Interested In Becoming Catholic?

Each year all the parishes send their RCIA candidates, sponsors and team to Holy Name Cathedral for the "Rite of Election." There are so many people involved that this prayer service is offered five times during Lent – and the cathedral is filled each time.

One of the most important aspects of our life at St. Raymond Parish is our continued efforts to share our faith with others. We do this in so many ways: through our liturgies, formation and education programs, outreach programs and our socializing and hospitality. We continually strive to create an atmosphere where God's active presence will be discovered among us.




