



# Thank You!

As we approach the end of the calendar year, here are a few thoughts and reminders, for maximizing the benefit of your generous contributions to St. Raymond.

Online Giving – For those of you that participate in online giving through Give Central and had a payment end date on your ongoing contributions, please review your account and adjust the date in order to continue your contributions for the "event" into the new year. Also, if you utilize credit card payment, please make sure your card number and expiration date are up to date.

Gifts from IRA Accounts - For donors 70½ or older, gifts up to \$100,000 can be made directly from an IRA account to the parish. These gifts not only count toward meeting minimum required distributions, they are not subject to income tax and can lower a donor's total income.


Gifts of Stock - Gifts of appreciated stock are among the best ways to give, since those gifts are not subject to capital gains tax, saving you up to 20% on your gift.





#### MUSIC CHOIR AREA AUDIO MIXERS

The music area sound was not included in the initial install of 2018, but was always a part of the upgrade plan at a later date, once we became more familiar with how to operate the rest of the system.

The music area was controlled by 2 analog mixers that had to be adjusted by going over to the closet and turning the knobs manually, not ideal in the middle of a liturgy. Like the rest of the previous sound system, the mixers were a few decades old. When it recently became clear that there were problems with buzzing, particularly on the livestream, and the mixers needed to be replaced, the planned upgrade for the music area was implemented.



#### DIGITAL MIXERS INSTALLED

We were able to use the same area for cabling which saved a ton of time and money. Some microphone and ports that haven't been working in years are now active just from the upgrade.

In addition, the mixers are in a proper rack and away from the lighting to keep any interference from occurring (buzzing).



#### SOUND MIXER PANELS

The digital mixers allow for digital control! We can now adjust all the mics on the fly in the music area to improve our in-person, recorded and live steaming experience.
