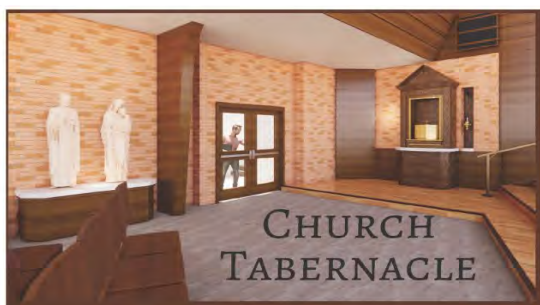

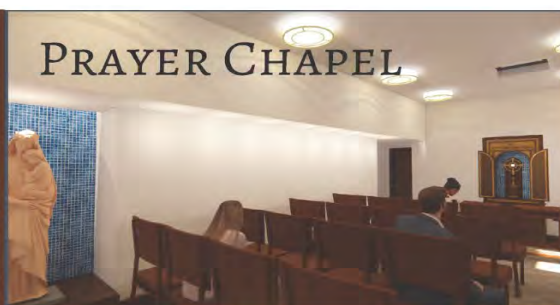

Mass is not just for high school. Contact Diana to participate as a lector, or Brian for Choir.

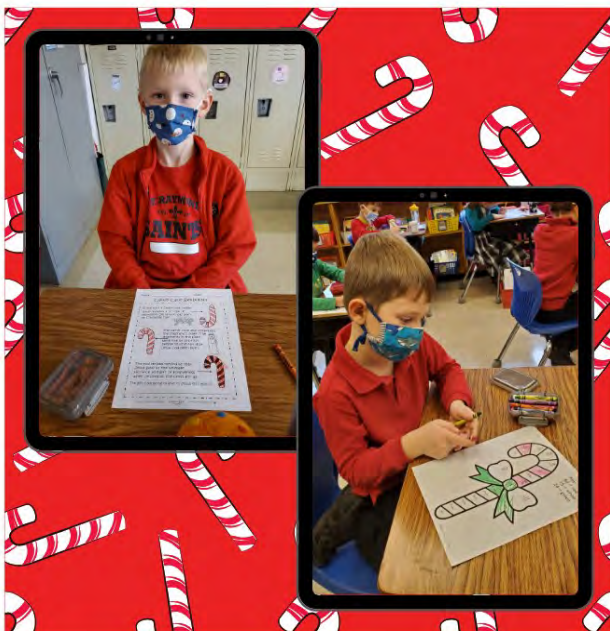

Candy Cane Lane in 1st Grade

The first graders had a sweet time learning during their candy cane-themed week. They discussed the symbolism behind this special Christmas candy, created a candy cane craft in the shape of "J" for Jesus and the shape of a shepherd's staff, and learned about how candy canes are made. The students also read the story *The Legend of the Candy Cane*. Candy canes even made an appearance in a science experiment where the students dissolved candy canes after making predictions as to which liquid - cold water, warm water, or vinegar - would dissolve a candy cane the fastest.

AWARENESS

Domestic violence is a pattern of behavior. It is used to exert power and control over another person. It is found in the context of a dating, family or household relationship.

Questions to ask:

- Does your partner isolate you from family and friends?
- Are you being physically, psychologically, economically or sexually abused?
- Is your partner attempting to destroy your self-esteem and self-confidence?

"I didn't know it was abuse."

 "I didn't tell anyone."

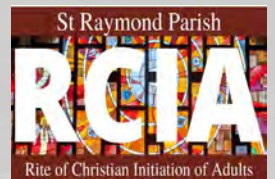
