CAPITAL PROJECTS AND MAINTENANCE COMMISSION

A YEAR-END 'TO TEACH WHO CHRIST IS' REVIEW FOR 2021

As we head into a new year (and the last for TTWCI pledges), it is most appropriate to once again thank all the St. Raymond parishioners who have so faithfully contributed to our TTWCI campaign over the years. At the end of December 2021, contributions of just over 2.4 million dollars have been received that have allowed improvements and maintenance throughout the SR campus. This figure will grow since there are still some pledge payments to be received.

Many of these have been highlighted before, but 2021 saw activity and expenditures in the following projects:

• Efficiency upgrade, improved controls, equipment replacement and asbestos removal for the church HVAC system	\$151,280
• PMC tuckpointing and chimney repair	\$96,797
• Reseal and stripe parking lot	\$11,070
• Audio/visual equipment for church and live-streaming	\$9,549
• Replace pulley system on wall behind church altar	\$2,700
• New signage around parish campus (pictured below)	\$12,495
• Replace school roof-top HVAC unit	\$6,750
• Payment to Archdiocese for TTWCI	<u>\$156,400</u>
Total for year	\$447, 041



Looking ahead to 2022, the remaining invoices for the church HVAC, campus signage, and the final TTWCI payment to the Archdiocese are still expected. When these are satisfied, there will remain in our account over \$200,000 for a reserve fund for future maintenance requirements which was one of the targets for the original campaign. As the TTWCI campaign winds down, just as you have been so generous, we will continue to be faithful stewards of your generosity in the months ahead.

Saint Raymond Youth Theatre Production of **The Music Man, Jr**

Grades 5 through 8

Auditions for the 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Students of Saint Raymond Parish (Day School & Religious Education) will be held in the Community Room on Saturday, February 19th (10 AM until noon), and on Sunday, February 20th (1:00 until 2:30 PM) in the PLC. Once you turn in your form you will be contacted with your scheduled audition day and time. All who audition will be cast in the show. Audition forms should be returned to the school office or the PMC marked "Spring Musical" by February 13th.

If you would like to try out for a solo singing part (a major or featured role), please **come prepared** with a show tune ready to perform in the character that you would like to portray. There will be select songs from the show (both music and lyrics) available at the school office or the PMC. It is recommended that you prepare a show tune so you can demonstrate your acting ability by singing your song in character. You do not have to sing at the audition in order to be in the show. Everyone who auditions will do one or two readings from the show. It is strongly advised that you learn as much as you can about the characters. **Do not bring songs to audition that are not from *The Music Man Jr.***

Grades 2 through 4

Students in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade will be cast in the ensemble. There are no auditions for these grades, however, if interested in being in the show they need to fill out a sign-up sheet and return it to the school office or the PMC marked "Spring Musical" by February 17th.

Rehearsals and Performances

The Music Man Jr. will be performed Thursday, May 26st, Friday, May 27th, Saturday, May 28th and Sunday, May 29th, in the PLC (Memorial Day Weekend). Rehearsals for grades 5 through 8 will usually be after school on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning February 28th from 3:30 until 5 PM in the PLC. Rehearsals for second to fourth graders will usually be on Fridays. The first rehearsal is scheduled for Friday, March 11th, from 4 until 5 PM in the PLC.

The Music Man Junior

Grades 5th to 8th fill out the entire form. Second to fourth graders fill out only the first five lines. Have a parent or guardian sign the form, and return the form to the school office or PMC marked "Spring Musical" by Feb. 13th.

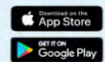
