1st Luminous Mystery - The Baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan

As Christ descends into the waters, the heavens open wide and the voice of the Father declares "This is my beloved Son with whom I am well pleased," while the Spirit descends on him to entrust him with the mission which he is to carry out.

2nd Luminous Mystery – The Wedding Feast at Cana

The first of the signs is given at Cana, when Christ changes water into wine and opens the hearts of the disciples to faith, thanks to the intervention of Mary, the first among believers.

3rd Luminous Mystery – The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God

The preaching by which Jesus proclaims the coming of the Kingdom of God, calls to conversion and forgives the sins of all who draw near to him in humble trust: the institution of that ministry of mercy which he continues to exercise until the end of the world.

4th Luminous Mystery - The Transfiguration of Jesus

The glory of God shines forth from the face of Jesus as the Father commands the astonished Apostles to 'listen to him' and to prepare to experience with him what was to come. Jesus revealed a small portion of His glory in His transfiguration to encourage his disciples, and us, filling us with hope for the rest of our journey.

5th Luminous Mystery – The Institution of the Eucharist

Christ offers his body and blood as food under the signs of bread and wine, and testifies 'to the end' his love for us, for whose salvation he will offer himself in sacrifice.

O GOD, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech You, that while meditating upon these mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.
