The Nicene Creed (can be Found in the front of the Gather Hymnal at number 174)

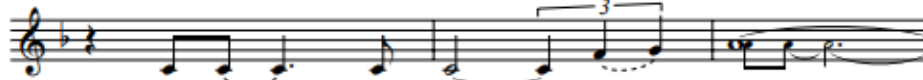
