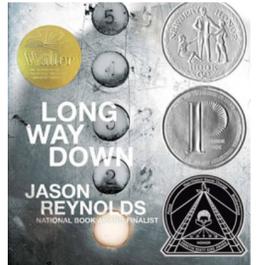
TEEN LENTEN BOOK CLUB

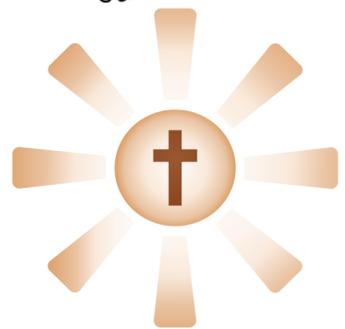
Mantra or repetitive songs, prayerful silence, and short readings guide the focus of the prayer in a candle-lit environment. Registration is not necessary - please join us!

This Holy Sacrament invites us to prayerfully examine our conscience, reflecting on how we have been living our lives, identifying what we have done or failed to do, and seeking forgiveness for the sins we have committed. Through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we are absolved from our sins and receive God's grace, which restores us to the right relationship with God and one another.
